Things have been quite quiet over the summer for the Parish Council as it does not hold any meetings in August.

Work however has been continuing on several projects including arranging for a permanent solution to prevent any future illegal encampments on the Playing Field. Metal bollards will be installed around the field by the end of September allowing us to have the unsightly concrete blocks removed.

VILLAGE HALL CAR PARK WORKS

Work has been taking place over the summer to make improvements to Village Hall car park. Accessibility to the North Hall for wheelchair users has been greatly improved and dedicated disabled parking bays have been created along the side of the Hall. A pathway has been created using barriers alongside the building to make it easier for pedestrians and wheelchair users to access the North Hall and the side doors of the main hall.

MAKING HAY WHILE THE SUN SHINES

It's a familiar saying; perhaps we began to lose sight of its' significance after such a long and generally uninterrupted period of fine weather. Equally, it is easy to get complacent and fail to seize important moments when they resent themselves in life generally.

I think of those occasions (before purchasing 'on-line' was an option!) when I may have been shopping with my wife. We saw the very thing she was looking for in the first shop we went into; but 'wisdom', 'caution' or the reluctance to grab what's on offer so early in the day persuaded us to "make sure" by looking elsewhere first; only to find - a couple of hours later – what we saw and was fit-for-purpose has now been sold and no further supplies are on order! So frustrating; even worse if we end up with something that is second-best.

There is a great temptation to put off making crucial decisions in matters of life and death. In my role as a Vicar there have been times when I sat with families in the shock of a sudden bereavement and when I needed to ask about the deceased's wishes, there was a tearful shaking of heads. This was the conversation that had always been put off and never broached; and now they have the anguish of having to make decision not really knowing whether they would be in line with their loved one's preferences.

The Bible says on more than one occasion 'Now is the day of salvation.' It is a reminder that in life we have choices about accepting God's provision for us, recognising Jesus as Saviour and knowing we are secure in His favour now and for eternity. These are examples of decisions we should not leave outstanding, in my view.

A few people have started recently to enquire about what it means to be 'baptised and confirmed'. This page is inadequate to give a complete answer; but in short asking the question can be one very helpful way of making sure we have faced up to these spiritual questions; making hay while the sun still shines on us!

What a summer we have had, with near tropical heat interspersed with monsoon-like days of rain! Now autumn is approaching, and what better time to join the Papworth Craft Group? Our numbers have swelled since the beginning of the year, but there is always room for new members.

We are hoping to produce some blankets for charity this autumn and winter. If you wish to join in, knitted squares are required in great numbers - four inches or just over ten centimetres, depending on whether you follow imperial or metric measurements.

If you do not wish to make any squares yourself, but have some yarn that you would like to donate, please bring it along to one of the Saturday meetings, and we shall turn it into squares for the blankets.

In the group there are some expert knitters who devote a great deal of their time producing items to raise much needed funds for the Papworth Day Centre.

There are others working on a variety of projects that will be sent to charities.

We can all follow their example, and knit, crochet, cross stitch, or embroider items that will go to help others, as well as working on projects for ourselves.

One of the most rewarding aspects of the group is the interaction of a bunch of individuals who would never have met, but for the Craft Group, and have created a dynamic, out of which come ideas to create a purpose beyond meeting twice a month.

Temperatures are dropping, the days are shortening, so it's time to start getting out the slow cookers.

If you do not have one then I would suggest you seriously look at one, they are a very usefull kitchen appliance that really helps with the hustle and bustle of our lives.

We are all very busy and a lot of us eat on the go, and at different times, or we want to eat as a family. Either way this is where this piece of equipment comes into its own.

You can leave it to cook all the ingredients very slowly while you are at work or out at play and when you get home a hot meal is waiting just to be served.

Below are some useful recipes that can be cooked for the family and just left to cook until you are ready to eat.

Creole Chicken and Sausage

Main Ingedients (just place in cooker and stir)

1 x pound boneless skinless chicken breasts

12 x ounces our chosen sausage, cut into small rounds

- 1 x cup chopped onions
- 2 x cloves minced garlic
- 1 x 1/4 cup low sodium chicken broth
- 1 x can (14.5 ounces) diced tomatoes
- 3 x tablespoons tomato paste
- 1/2 x cup tomato sauce
- 2 x teaspoons Creole seasoning
- 1/4 x teaspoon cayenne

- 2 x green bell peppers, chopped

Veggie Lasagna

Main Ingedients (just place in cooker and stir)

- 2 x 24 ounce jars or cans of Italian tomato sauce
- 9 x thick lasagna noodles
- 24 x ounces part-skim ricotta cheese or cottage cheese
- 3 to 4 x cups chopped vegetables of choice
- 2 x cups shredded Mozzarella or Provolone cheese

Parmesan cheese for topping

Fresh parsley for topping

Just leave to cook in the slow cooker as per your cookers instructions.

Bread Pudding

Main Ingedients

8 x cups 1-inch cubes day-old French bread

- 1/2 x cup raisins, if desired
- 2 x cups milk
- 4 x eggs
- 1 x cup sugar
- 1/4 x cup butter, melted
- 1 x teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 x teaspoon vanilla
- 1/4 x teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/8 x teaspoon salt

Whipped cream, if desired

Method

Spray slow cooker with cooking spray.

Place bread and raisins in slow cooker.

In medium bowl, beat milk, eggs, sugar, melted butter, cinnamon, vanilla, nutmeg and salt with whisk; pour over bread and raisins. Toss to evenly coat. Let stand 10 minutes. Toss again to make sure custard is evenly distributed.

Cover and cook on Low heat setting $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 hours or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Serve warm with whipped cream.

Cook in the slow cooker as per your cooking instructions above
