

Could you help Cambridgeshire Sands support bereaved parents?

Still birth and neo-natal death charity Sands are seeking local volunteers to help their already established group in Cambridgeshire.



"I found out my baby had died just before Christmas. There are no words to describe the utter despair that I felt" These are the words of a bereaved parent who was supported by Sands.

Not all Committee members have to be bereaved parents......

Losing your much longed for baby during pregnancy or shortly after is the most awful trauma any parent can experience. A whole future is taken away from that family. Sadly this happens only too often. Currently 15 babies a day die in the weeks before or just after birth. And this figure only includes those who die after 24 weeks of gestation. Many more die in the weeks before that. Sands aims to care for all of those families who lose their much longed for baby with practical and emotional support for as long as they need it.

Sands is one of the leading stillbirth and neo-natal charities in the UK. We work nationally to reduce baby deaths through promoting better maternity care and funding research. We have a programme of training designed to support professionals to improve bereavement care they provide following the death of a baby. We provide resources and equipment to enable hospitals to provide the best and most appropriate care and support to families. Sands provides a comprehensive bereavement support service both nationally and locally through around 100 regional support groups based across the UK, our National Helpline, an on-line forum and now our recently introduced App.

Cambridgeshire Sands is looking for new volunteers to join their Committee or train to become Befrienders so they can continue to support their local hospitals and bereaved parents.

Befrienders-who are usually bereaved parents or grandparents-are needed to provide support to anyone affected by the death of a baby over the phone or in person at the Group Support Meetings each month. New Befrienders must successfully complete our befriender training and a minimum of two years must have passed since their baby died.

Climate Change and Environment Strategy Consultation

Cambridgeshire County Council declared a Climate and Environment Emergency in May 2019.

As part of this declaration the Council is developing a Climate Change and Environment Strategy and Action Plan.

The strategy outlines how they will:

- reduce the carbon footprint of the Council and the County
- help communities adapt to the change already happening
- enhance nature and the benefits it provides.

As part of the strategy development, the County Council is keen to understand what communities think of the targets and actions they have set themselves and how you can work with them to bring forward some of the changes that are needed to the way we live and work.

A consultation on the draft Strategy and Action Plan is currently open, and Cambridgeshire County Council would like to invite you to review it and provide feedback.

The consultation is available online until 31 January 2020, where you will find a copy of the Strategy documents and questionnaire, through which you can provide feedback.

Your responses will be highly valuable to the County Council and will ensure that the Strategy meets the needs of local communities as well as the Council.

Papworth Hospital Site

The Parish Council were disappointed to hear that the sale of the old Royal Papworth Hospital site had fallen through and that the site is once again being marketed for sale.

We hope that the future of the site can be secured quickly and look forward to seeing what proposals are put forward.

In the meantime the site will continue to be used by Cambridgeshire Constabulary and Cambridgeshire Fire and Rescue Service for training purposes.

The Royal Papworth Hospital Trust has confirmed that the sales of both the Queen Mary's and St Peter's nurses' home have been secured.

Room Name Change

In tribute to former Parish Councillor Bob Baker, who sadly passed away last year, the Parish Council has sought a way to honour Bob's many years of service on the Council.

With the approval of Bob's widow Betty, the Parish Council has renamed the Seminar Room at the Village Hall as the "Bob Baker Room".

Here we go!

I can't recall a time when what happened at the end of the old year had such momentous implications for the new year we are now in. Like many, I am glad the outcome of the General Election has given us clarity about the direction of travel and a government for the nation with the means to implement its manifesto promises.

As a Christian, I believe the impact of the birth of Jesus was similarly transformative, although at the time none but a handful of people realised what was going on. What is markedly different, however, is God's purposes have never been in doubt and His ability to deliver remained intact throughout.

I am conscious there will be people reading this article who have begun 2020 with a heavy heart and much of what lies ahead fills you with anxiety, fear and great uncertainty.

One of the compelling attractions, in my view, of the Christian faith is the way Jesus said regularly 'Fear not ... don't worry ...': He recognised the instinct of many to live always looking over our shoulders, so-to-speak; and the need to translate a set of beliefs into an inner confidence that affects how we feel every day.

The point about embracing the Christian way is not that we avoid the things that trouble others but that we know how to live through such circumstances with a smile and confidence that God is on hand and will not abandon us.

In Jesus' day there were many people who thought their nation needed a political solution. Jesus disappointed them and refused to dance to that tune. Along the way he had dealings with politicians and never went out of his way to tell them how to do their job! Accordingly, he was neither for nor against them and believed that ultimately, they did not have the power or influence to countermand God's prevailing will with him.

All of us will be affected by the decisions and activities of politicians working locally, nationally and globally. That's why as Christians we pray for them; they have serious responsibilities, a sober calling and yet still limited power and authority.

One of the privileges of the Christian Church is we can invite people to do life with God and not have to feel we are constantly 'under the circumstances'. That we do this badly too often is a source of regret but as we start a new year with new opportunities and new challenges we get to continue with this contribution.

Hitherto, you may not have seen Christianity as life-enhancing. Maybe 2020 is the year to think again, to taste and see that the Lord is good!



Skating/scootering/cycling are great ways to exercise, they're skill-based, out on the fresh air, good for mental health, and away from screens.

A park dedicated to two wheels would keep riders away from the areas of the village where they might cause disturbance.


As a first step, Matty has emailed both the Parish Council and Varrier Jones Foundation.
