Following a cyclical tree survey Papworth Trust carried out essential safety works to over 130 trees in Barons Way Wood during July 2021. This involved the felling of several trees and removing of deadwood. All of the material was left on site and recycled for habitat for birds and insects.


#### What to see and hear in September....

#### **Tawny Owls**

Who has heard the Tawny Owl this year? He starts calling at dusk, and continues on and off for most of the night, only stopping at daylight. I would love to find him and watch him.

The home territory of a Tawny Owl is usually established in late Autumn, but the Papworth one seems to have a started early. The territory covers about 30 to 50 acres and is defended throughout the winter until breeding time in the Spring. Maybe we could encourage the land owners to erect some owl boxes to encourage him to stay. Tawny Owls are on the amber list so anything to help them would be good.

September is your last chance to spot this bird of prey as they will soon be Africa bound until next spring. They specialise in catching dragonflies, swallows, martins and swifts, none of which can be found in the UK in the winter. Your best bet to see these birds locally before they start to leave is RSPB Fen Drayton Pits or RSPB The Lodge Sandy. It can be quite breathtaking to see them swoop and dive after their prey.

**Red Fox** 



We have a couple of Jays in the Papworth Woods. Jays are widespread in the British Isles and doing well. They are our shyest species of crow, spending most of their time moving quietly around the trees where they hunt out nests of eggs and recently fledged young birds. But all this changes between September and November. As late summer turns to autumn, the birds start amassing hoards of acorns and other nuts and seeds to see them through the winter. Not only do they spend longer on the ground foraging, they also fly to and fro to bury their treasure. However, not all the acorns are found again, which means some of them are left to grow into Oak Trees. They can be easily spotted by their white rumps and loud calls earning them the old name 'screamer of the woods'.



Foxes are opportunists, they do not waste any time in searching out the late summer, or early autumn, fruit bounty; they will happily feast on blackberries, low hanging apples, pears or plums.

In September, the adults and cubs have nearly finished growing their new thicker winter coats. The juveniles have now also grown close to adult size. Competition between the young foxes, and also the young and adult foxes can become quite fierce. The resulting scuffles can be very noisy with rivals chasing each other and squaring up to each other, sometimes onto their hind legs. So listen out.

# Update on Covid 19 vaccinations for 16-17 year

olds (Updated 17th August 2021)

16 and 17 year olds can now attend any mass vaccination walk in centre to be immunised. Details of your nearest vaccination centre can be found on the NHS website.

Teenagers within three months of turning 18 can book their vaccine appointment online through the National Booking Service or by calling 119.

Currently 16 and up to 17 3/4 will only be offered one jab. Anyone over 17 3/4 will be offered 2 jabs. It may be decided later to second jab over 16 and 17 year olds.

#### Update on Covid 19 vaccinations for 12-15 year olds

Children aged 12 to 15 who are clinically vulnerable to Covid, or live with adults who are at an increased risk of serious illness, will be contacted by the NHS and invited to book their jabs in thr coming weeks.

Decorating: Papworth surgery has been undergoing a makeover in recent weeks. We are in the process of painting all the walls and replacing all the floors. We are also installing more air conditioning units to help make the surgery more comfortable in hot weather. This is a huge undertaking, which hopefully won't cause too much disruption to the normal running of the surgery. We hope you like to surgery's new look!

**Appointments:** We have unprecedented demand for appointments at present as the huge pressure on General Practice, triggered by the pandemic, continues. We are constantly reviewing the way in which we work to find the best solutions for this. Each day half of our appointments are "pre-bookable" i.e. can be booked in advance online or on the phone. We usually have plenty of pre-bookable appointments available within the following 7-10 days. The other half are reserved for medically urgent problems i.e. those that must be seen the same day. If your problem is not medically urgent then please do not book these slots. Please book an upcoming pre-bookable appointment instead. Our medically urgent appointments are released at 08:30 and 1:30 each day. Please be kind to our receptionists who are working very hard in exceptional circumstances.

It's not a small job, as the pool has to be vacuumed to remove debris for around two hours a day and the water treated and tested 3-4 times a day and the pump filters flushed and cleaned – in addition to maintaining the general area. The guys have been out in all weathers ensuring the pool is safe and clean for our children to use - and have done a fantastic job !

continue throughout the Autumn and Winter. Everyone over 50 years or with underlying health conditions is eligible and we will be sending invites. We are holding Saturday clinics on 25th September, 16th October and 6th November. Please do book in for your jab. For those who have mobile phones, please ensure we have an up to date number as we will send you a text with a link so that you can book into a flu clinic directly.

**Covid:** Covid remains a significant risk and continues to have an impact on all our lives. For the safety of everyone you must wear a face covering when attending the surgery, unless you are exempt. Anyone 16 years or over who is yet to be vaccinated for covid, please book a slot at a local vaccination centre by calling 119 or booking via NHS online. I'm afraid there is still no announcement from the government about how at risk 12-15 year olds will be vaccinated, as this cannot be done at the local vaccination centres. We have a list of those who need vaccination and will be in touch as soon as we hear. The plans for covid vaccination booster jabs are also not finalised. Please note however, that these will be provided by local vaccination centres and not by the practice or the Primary Care Network (PCN).

**Staff:** We are delighted to announce that our new Nurse Practitioner Cara Garney will be joining the practice in September. She is hugely experienced, especially in chronic disease management, and will be taking over from Claire Hodge in leading the diabetes clinics. Dr Coulson will be returning from maternity leave in early October.

#### As time goes by Nigel di Castiglione ... Team Rector

Sometimes we think 'Where has all that time gone?' whilst for many a gradual resumption of 'normality' seems to have taken for ever.

As we bump into friends and family again, we may notice how one person has aged, others

have changed their hair style, another has put on/lost a lot of weight and so forth; whilst there have to be conversations, perhaps tears in the mix, about the 'life-events' – weddings funerals and the like severely constrained by 'lockdown' regulations.

Some in England dubbed July 19th 2021 'Freedom Day' but with it comes the question "What is freedom?" The answer is more complex than we might prefer; for example, to wear or discard a face mask is about more than what makes me feel safe and comfortable, and just as much to safeguard others I mix with.

"Freedom" is a particularly strong motif in the Christian tradition. A careful study of the Bible reveals this freedom is found in and modelled supremely by Jesus. As a result it is always purposeful, facilitates mutual flourishing and serves the common good.

One of the features of such freedom is that, by and large, with increasing maturity comes ever-increasing displays of the wise and effective use of our capacity to make choices and exercise influence around others. More simply, growing older can be about becoming better!

A benefit and challenge of the pandemic has been that many have been given time to redeploy; because we weren't driven by routines (often good and essential ones) we had grown accustomed to over many years. We are now at the point of being able to ask ourselves "What have I learned ... what should be different moving forward ... am I better as a person or have I wasted this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity?"

There are some things we can never go back to; most poignantly, the funeral of a loved one we were not able to attend. Will I live with regret, anger, disappointment or remorse and adopt a 'victimmentality'; or (as a sign of growing maturity) realise I am designed to live just one day at a time, end each day having refused to 'let the sun go down on my anger' and make sure I do not ignore the inner prompting (what some call the "whispers of heaven") to do something NOW, not procrastinating until another day what can be achieved today?




